This true classic was first served in the 1860s at Gaspare Campari's bar in Milan Italy. It was named 'Milano-Torino' because of the origins of its two primary ingredients: Campari calls Milan home and sweet vermouth is also known as 'Vermouth di Torino' or Italian vermouth. The cocktail was later renamed because of its popularity among American tourists around the turn of the	
20th century and prior to the Prohibition.	
It's also fascinating to note that the Americano spurred the creation of another famous Campari cocktail in the 20s, The 'Negroni', it's said, was invented because one Count Camillo Negroni ordered an 'America with gin' while at a café in Florence, Italy.	ano
APEROL SPRITZ Aperol, Cantine Lamberti Prosecco, San Pellegrino	18
Aperol Spritz became popular in the 1950s, inspired by the Venetian mix of white wine and soda. The drink incorporates the Italian aperitif Aperol, which originated in Padua, Italy, in 1919 as a light liqueur alternative.  It is the most popular summer drink of Italy and is perfect for a nice spring or summer day in Mooloolaba.

NEGRONI Campari, Tanqueray No10 Gin, Martini Rosso,	18
While the drink's origins are unknown, the most widely reported account is that it was first mixed in Florence, Italy, in 1919, at Caffè Casoni (formerly Caffè Giacosa), located on Via de' Tornabuoni and now called Caffè Roberto Cavalli. Count Camillo Negroni concocted it by asking the bartender, Fosco Scarselli, to strengthen his favorite cocktail, the Americano, by adding gin rather than the normal soda water.  The bartender also added an orange garnish rather than the typical lemon garnish of the Americano to signify that it was a different drink.

The drink was invented and named by Ian Fleming in the 1953 James Bond novel Casino Royale.	
A Vesper differs from Bond's usual cocktail of choice, the martini, in that it uses both gin and vodka, Kina Lillet instead of the usual dry vermouth, and a lemon peel instead of an olive. Although there is a lot of discussion on the Vesper, it is only ordered by Bond once throughout Fleming's novels—although Bond drinks the Vesper in the film Casino Royale—and by later books Bond is ordering regular vodka martinis, though he also drinks regular gin martinis. Felix Leiter ordered a Vesper for Bond in the novel Diamonds Are Forever, albeit with Cresta Blanca in place of Kina Lillet, which Bond politely remarks is the "Best Vermouth I ever tasted." It may be that Fleming decided not to have Bond order a Vesper again due to the way in which Casino Royale ends.

On the palate, flavors of cooked fruit (quince jelly and apricot jam) happily mingle with fragrances of beeswax and acacia honey. The long lasting aromas, composed of both fuity (candied orange peel and tangerine) and spicy notes (cardamom) is outstanding.

Opaque purple, it gives off an ethereal bouquet of violets, saddle leather, blueberry, blackberry, pencil lead, and chocolate. This is followed by a full-bodied wine with tremendous concentration, multiple layers of flavor, ripe tannins, and great balance. Thick and rich, with a 60-second finish, it will slowly blossom over the next 15-20 years and provide pleasure through 2050.

# ITALIAN WINE CLASSIFICATIONS

# Denominazione di Origine Controllata e Garantita (DOCG)

This classification denotes the highest quality recognition for Italian wines. It is comprised of a relatively limited number of first-class wines. DOCG wines must meet all of the label requirements that the DOC wine must maintain with added caveats indicating stringent vineyard yield, grape types grown within precise boundaries, specific alcohol levels, and minimum aging requirements. Tuscany and Piedmont carry the most DOCG wines in Italy.

# Denominazione di Origine Controllata (DOC)

Basically the equivalent of the French wine classification, Appellation d'Origine Controlee (AOC). Wines that fall under the DOC category must be made in specified, government defined zones, in accordance with particular regulations that are intended to preserve the wine's character that is uniquely derived from Italy's individual regions. There are currently over 300 DOC wines in Italy, all adhering to specific vineyard trellising, irrigation and vinification requirements detailing which grapes may be grown and where along with aging requirements and alcohol limits.

## Indicazione di Geografica Tipica (IGT)

These table wines are often ubiquitous wines that are grown in specific geographical growing regions. However, there are exceptions -- some of Italy's best wines (aka the "Super Tuscans") do fall under this category just to avoid more stringent regulations associated with DOC or DOCG and allow for more vineyard experimentation.


#### WINE REGIONS OF BORDEAUX



As a very broad generalisation, Cabernet Sauvignon (Bordeaux's second-most planted grape variety) dominates the blend in red wines produced in the Médoc and the rest of the left bank of the Gironde estuary. Typical top-quality Châteaux blends are 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Cabernet Franc and 15% Merlot. This is typically referred to as the "Bordeaux Blend". Merlot tends to predominate in Saint-Émilion, Pomerol and the other right bank appellations. These Right Bank blends from top-quality Châteaux are typically 70% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Franc and 15% Cabernet Sauvignon.

The **Bordeaux Wine Official Classification of 1855** resulted from the 1855 Exposition Universelle de Paris, when Emperor Napoleon III requested a classification system for France's best Bordeaux wines that were to be on display for visitors from around the world. Brokers from the wine industry ranked the wines according to a château's reputation and trading price, which at that time was directly related to quality.

The wines were ranked in importance from first to fifth growths (crus). All of the red wines that made it on the list came from the Médoc region except for one: Château Haut-Brion from Graves



2015 Dominus Estate Napa Valley, California USA 1500 (86% Cabernet Sauvignon/9% Petit Verdot/5% Cabernet Franc)

In the late 1960's, while attending the university of California at Davis, Christian Moueix fell in love with the Napa Valley and its wines. Son of Jean-Pierre Moueix, the fames wine merchant and producer from Lisbourne, France, Moueix returned home in 1970 to manage the family vineyards, including Chateaux Petrus, La Fleur-Petrus, Trotanoy in Pomerol and Magdelaine in Saint Emilion.

His love of Napa Valley lingered and in 1981, he discovered the historic Napanook vineyard, a 124-Acre site west of Yountville that had been the source of fruit for some of the finest Napa Valley wines of the 1940's and the 1950's. In 1982, Moueix entered into a partnership to develop the vineyard and in 1995, became its sole owner. He chose the name 'Dominus' or 'Lord of the Estate' in Latin to underscore his longstanding commitment to stewardship of the land.

#### 2015 Dominus Estate 100\* Points

"The 2015 Dominus is a flawless perfect wine as well as a legend in the making. A blend of 86% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Petit Verdot and the rest Cabernet Franc, from dry-farmed vines and brought up in just 40% new French oak, its ruby/purple colour is followed by an extraordinary bouquet of blackcurrents, crème de casis, damp earth, smoke tobacco, and spring flowers.

Reminding me of the 2015 Chateau Margaux with its incredible mix of elegance and power, this beauty hits the palate with full-bodied richness, stunning purity of fruit, building tannins, and awesome length. This sensational textured and voluptuous Dominus drinks well today yet will evolve for 25-30 years or more."

"Bottled in July 2017 and composed of 86% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Petit Verdot and 5% Cabernet Franc, the Dominus 2015 Propriety Red leaps from the glass with notes of fresh wild blueberries, crushed blackberries and black currant juice with touches of wild thyme, underbrush, iron ore and aniseed with wafts of lavender and pencil lead. Medium to full-bodied, the palate has incredible energy and vivacity, with the firm, pixelated tannins and lively backbone skilfully framing the muscular fruit, finishing with wonderful length and depth.
