Gin for Tonic was the brainchild of an avid gin lover, frustrated with the way tonic over powers the delicate flavours of the spirit. The goal was to create a beautiful and elegant gin that stood its ground to become perfectly balanced and that's how Broken Spectre Gin For Tonic was born.
We recommend serving on ice with any Fever Tree tonic or martini.
- BROCKEN SPECTRE ‘Summer Gin’** *Tasmania, Australia* 20
The Tasmanian Summer Gin is infused with locally grown saffron post distillation, giving the liquid and golden hue and allowing the full rich flavor of the spice to create a distinct powerful spirit.
We recommend serving on ice with Fever Tree Light Tonic or Martini.
- FOUR PILLARS ‘Shiraz Gin’** *Vic, Australia* 18
Pine Forrest notes, white pepper and spices, and the gin is beautifully balanced with a delicious Sweetness and nice tannins to finish. Nice with fresh lemon and a quality tonic.
- HUSK DISTILLERS ‘Ink Gin’** *Tweed Valley, NSW* 18
Bright blue and indigo hues changing to pink when mixed with natural acidity including tonic water, lemon and lime. The nose is shows fragrant citrus followed by fresh pine, coriander, juniper and sweet orange. The taste begins from fresh lemon myrtle then leads onto subtle pepper berry and citrus notes
We recommend serving on ice with Fever Tree Mediterranean Tonic.
- HARTSHORN ‘Sheep Whey Gin’** *Tasmania, Australia* 21
This distillery is a new Tasmanian micro distillery making boutique batches of gin from their own sheep whey. They are the first in the world to create this unique product. Hartshorn use only Australian native botanicals (plus juniper). 3 of them never used before in any other gin.
We recommend serving on ice with Fever Tree Indian Tonic.
- MALFY ‘Con Limone Gin’** *Italy* 18
Malfy used a selection of coastal grown Italian lemons-some from Amalfi and some from Sicily to give the gin a fresh zesty aroma. Using Italian juniper and five other botanical including coriander, angelica and cassia bark to give the gin a delicious and refreshing bite.
We recommend serving with Fever Tree Mediterranean Tonic or Martini.
- NEVER NEVER ‘Juniper Freak Gin’** *South Australia* 21
2017 Limited batch release. The Juniper Freak is a celebration of Juniper. Its an oiled-up beast of a gin. Wonderfully intense, aromatic, flavoursome gin. Fragrant pine and earthy angelica with a touch of pepper berry spice. Incredibly long finish, with resinous juniper oils coating the palate and pepper berry developing late.
We recommend serving on the rocks with Fever Tree Indian tonic or martini.

<i>While the drink's origins are unknown, the most widely reported account is that it was first mixed in Florence, Italy, in 1919, at Caffè Casoni (formerly Caffè Giacosa), located on Via de' Tornabuoni and now called Caffè Roberto Cavalli. Count Camillo Negroni concocted it by asking the bartender, Fosco Scarselli, to strengthen his favorite cocktail, the Americano, by adding gin rather than the normal soda water.</i>	
<i>The bartender also added an orange garnish rather than the typical lemon garnish of the Americano to signify that it was a different drink.</i>

<i>A Vesper differs from Bond's usual cocktail of choice, the martini, in that it uses both gin and vodka, Kina Lillet instead of the usual dry vermouth, and a lemon peel instead of an olive. Although there is a lot of discussion on the Vesper, it is only ordered by Bond once throughout Fleming's novels – although Bond drinks the Vesper in the film Casino Royale – and by later books Bond is ordering regular vodka martinis, though he also drinks regular gin martinis. Felix Leiter ordered a Vesper for Bond in the novel Diamonds Are Forever, albeit with Cresta Blanca in place of Kina Lillet, which Bond politely remarks is the "Best Vermouth I ever tasted." It may be that Fleming decided not to have Bond order a Vesper again due to the way in which Casino Royale ends.</i>

Barolo is made from the Nebbiolo grape from the Piemonte region of Italy and is often described as one of Italy's greatest wines. Barolo, is often described as having the aromas of Tar & Roses and the wines are noted for their ability to age and usually take on a red rust tinge as they mature.

Barolo needs to be aged for 38 months after the harvest before release, of which 18 months must be in wood.

Barbaresco is made from the Nebbiolo grape and produced in the Piemonte area of Italy.

The wine is often compared to Barolo-another Nebbiolo based wine from the Piemonte area.

Despite being made from the same grape and produced in neighboring areas less than 10miles from each other, the wines of Barbaresco and Barolo do have some distinct differences.

Located south of the river Tanaro, the Barbaresco zone receives a slight maritime influence which allows Nebbiolo to ripen here a little earlier than it does in the Barolo zone.

The most pronounced differences between the two is the tannins of Barbaresco tend to soften quicker which makes the wine more approachable to drink at an earlier age but allow it to age for as long as a Barolo could.

Amarone della Valpolicella, usually known as Amarone, is typically a rich dry red wine made from the partially dried grapes of Corivina, Corvinone (45-95%), Rondinella (5-30%) and other red grape varieties (up to 25%).

Made with the apassimento method, wines take up to 50 days to ferment.

In Amarone the quality of the grape skin is a primary concern, as that component brings the tannins, colour and intensity of the wine.

The final result is a very ripe, raisiny, full-bodied wine with very little acid. The wine is rarely released until 5 years after the vintage.

Expect flavours of black cherry, fig, and dark chocolate.

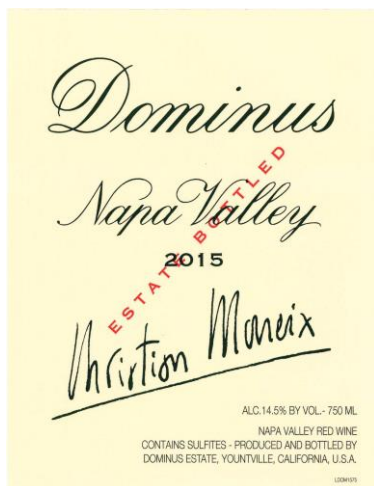
WINE REGIONS OF BORDEAUX



As a very broad generalisation, Cabernet Sauvignon (Bordeaux's second-most planted grape variety) dominates the blend in red wines produced in the Médoc and the rest of the left bank of the Gironde estuary. Typical top-quality Châteaux blends are 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Cabernet Franc and 15% Merlot. This is typically referred to as the "Bordeaux Blend". Merlot tends to predominate in Saint-Émilion, Pomerol and the other right bank appellations. These Right Bank blends from top-quality Châteaux are typically 70% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Franc and 15% Cabernet Sauvignon.

The **Bordeaux Wine Official Classification of 1855** resulted from the 1855 Exposition Universelle de Paris, when Emperor Napoleon III requested a classification system for France's best Bordeaux wines that were to be on display for visitors from around the world. Brokers from the wine industry ranked the wines according to a château's reputation and trading price, which at that time was directly related to quality.

The wines were ranked in importance from first to fifth growths (crus). All of the red wines that made it on the list came from the Médoc region except for one: Château Haut-Brion from Graves

In the late 1960's, while attending the university of California at Davis, Christian Moueix fell in love with the Napa Valley and its wines. Son of Jean-Pierre Moueix, the famed wine merchant and producer from Lisbourne, France, Moueix returned home in 1970 to manage the family vineyards, including Chateaux Petrus, La Fleur-Petrus, Trotanoy in Pomerol and Magdelaine in Saint Emilion.

His love of Napa Valley lingered and in 1981, he discovered the historic Napanook vineyard, a 124-Acre site west of Yountville that had been the source of fruit for some of the finest Napa Valley wines of the 1940's and the 1950's. In 1982, Moueix entered into a partnership to develop the vineyard and in 1995, became its sole owner. He chose the name 'Dominus' or 'Lord of the Estate' in Latin to underscore his longstanding commitment to stewardship of the land.

This sensational textured and voluptuous Dominus drinks well today yet will evolve for 25-30 years or more."
